lived and ruled. They were great patrons of music. Haydn, who was born near this delightful city, was closely associated with the family. Visit the Palace and possible concert venue. Dinner and overnight in Vienna.

Departure this morning for Salzburg, which is the birthplace of Mozart. En route you will drive through the beautiful region of Salzkammergut. Stop in Mondsee where, for the movie 'The sound of Music' the local church was used for the wedding scene. Dinner and overnight in Salzburg.

APRIL 2

A walking tour of the city will be on this morning's program. Visit Mozart's home where he was born and see some of the sites where the movie Sound of Music was filmed. There is time to relax this afternoon as well as to prepare for a possible concert venue in the late afternoon or early evening.
